A Letter from our Founder

Dear Donors,

This year has been one of jubilation in seeing the overturning of Roe v. Wade. As we celebrated the constitutional changes to the legal status of abortion, nothing at A Baby's Breath has changed. We continue to offer free help to mothers and families in a crisis pregnancy. As we can see with the last election, the battle continues for us to be the source of hope for all who need us.

During the general election period, there was a constant barrage of advertisements about how a mother's life would be threatened if all abortions were banned. This would simply not be the case since the definition of an abortion is a "direct and willful action to end a pregnancy". We saw firsthand this play out with a pregnancy that had to be ended in Warminster. The ultrasound technician observed the beating heart inside the Fallopian tubes. To continue the pregnancy would have resulted in death to both the mother and the baby. There was no hesitation to refer this mother to the ER where one of her tubes was removed. Until technology exists to save both mother and baby, the mother's life is always the priority. The only thing that would change with an abortion on demand law is the decision to live life without virtue.

Abortion is too often used as an alternative birth control method. Almost every client that we help is on some form of birth control which is why we advocate for chastity for single mothers and Natural Family Planning classes to married couples.

The core services that we provide encourage and support clients who are choosing life. We do this through compassionate counseling that helps them to make better decisions. At each of our five centers, we have volunteer advocates who are trained to listen and give positive answers to the questions of how to get through their crises.

Our home in Phoenixville continues to provide the safe haven needed as it did for 4 homeless mothers in the past year. They benefited from the wonderful volunteers at the home who provided guidance with jobs, budgets and credit analysis. It is our goal for all of our clients to work to become independent of government support as it is how we function at A Baby's Breath without accepting government support and operating with volunteer leadership.

The Independence program which offers financial assistance to those working through their crises will graduate one mother through the program and accepting a new mother with 3 children including one with special needs. The Independence board is comprised of business individuals who assist our Independence clients with their financial goals and rewards.

Our founder Karen Patota is starting to teach other organizations her methods that are featured in her book, entitled Creating Compassionate Places. She is training seminarians to do the work of advocates and is inviting groups to tour the centers to see how one can provide Catholic Social Services to people who need help "...to see a mother take her child take his/her first breath."

A Baby's Breath is a 501(C)3 organization that is a model for social services. Currently, we have locations in Jeffersonville, Collegeville, Wayne, Warminster and Phoenixville, PA.

About A Baby's Breath

A Baby's Breath started as one crisis pregnancy center 22 years ago. We began with just offering baby items with a mission "...to help a mother to see her baby take his/her first breath." After one year of operation, it became clear that our mission needed to include more than the mom and more than just the first breath. Over that past 22 years, we have helped over 5,000 families with their crisis pregnancies before, during and after the first breath.

We moved from our first center in Fairview Village to our Jeffersonville location in 2011. A larger space accommodated our first parenting and prenatal classes. We were able to develop a system of distributing baby items that would teach our parents how to be responsible parents and to give them important information about safety, nutrition and budgeting. Our Baby Store program is the way that we draw our clients to the important services needed to transform their lives. This past year, our Jeffersonville center has provided much needed services of pregnancy counseling, and material assistance to our English and Spanish speaking clients as we began offering in person services once again. We partnered with two local churches for our parenting classes. Our Natural Family Planning was introduced at one of our parenting classes and on-going NFP classes are available at this center and is free for all engaged and married couples, English and Spanish speaking is available now.

One center grew to three in 5 years. Our Collegeville center had Planned Parenthood as its neighbors until they closed, leaving our organization as the only one in the community devoted to helping moms, dads and families in crisis pregnancy. Our Collegeville center was the first to have an ultrasound machine. Our twin baby girls who were saved last year via our the ultrasound service continue to thrive and their parents are grateful that we provided the ultrasound service so that could see their beautiful gifts in utero. Their parents are now grateful donors of our center.

The center that is closest to many local colleges is our Wayne center. Our 14-year journey on the Main Line has seen the closing of a functioning Planned Parenthood less than a mile away. The new director is doing an amazing job at developing the volunteer base. She's been helping families with the material and emotional support needed in properly caring for their children.

Our fourth center in Warminster which is still close to a functioning Planned Parenthood is in its 12 year of operation. The veteran staff continues to provide quality care for crisis moms, dads and families in a crisis pregnancy before, during and after the crisis pregnancy. The ultrasound service at Warminster provided a glimpse of a life-threatening situation for a mom – an ectopic pregnancy. The mom was referred to the ER where her Fallopian tube was removed. Until technology exists to save both, a mother's life is the priority.

Our first home in PHX opened in October, 2016. We have provided 14 mothers with a place to live while working through their crises during the pandemic. Our core services director is helping our residents with the needed emotional support which we provide through our pregnancy counseling services. We have a new housing admission person. We are still in need of some administrative help, however the home has never been better administered.

Our Independence program provides incentives for our Independence clients to get credits for actions taken e.g. getting/maintaining a better job, finishing their education and staying clean. Our Independence program has disbursed critically needed funds for our clients who are achieving their goals and making significant progress in shaping the new direction of their lives. We currently have 4 clients in the Independence program. Those participating in the program choose to move from the cycle of dependence to freedom making positive and constructive choices for the future.

The Silent Auction proceeds go towards the shared costs of insurances, cell phones, and the consultant fees for our organization. Our budget is about \$200,000 for providing our core services, housing and Independence services. We have 2 ½ years of reserves because of the wealth of support given to us by our donors and our volunteer leadership. What we do is a testament to our faith and our witness to life. We continue to exist because of donors like you who care enough about our mission to join us.





FREE Ultrasound Services



A Baby's Breath offers free limited obstetrical ultrasounds to women who are 6 to 14 weeks pregnant. Our scans are intended to offer the client information about three things: confirming the location of her pregnancy, detecting fetal cardiac activity, and determining fetal age. Seventy-five to eighty percent of abortion-minded women who see their baby on ultrasound will choose life. Both the Collegeville and Warminster Centers offer this service and

we have seen women fall in love with their babies very early.

We are grateful to all those who lovingly help provide these ultrasounds to our clients.

We need two more volunteer sonographers in our Warminster location



Our ultrasound service is available to mothers and fathers who need to see their baby before he/she is born. If you are one of those parents, send us a message and arrange for a phone/zoom consultation on how this service works. Following a positive urine pregnancy test observed by our staff at one of our five centers, we can set up an appointment for a Limited Ultrasound in our Collegeville or Warminster Center. These ultrasounds are performed between 6 and 14 weeks following the first day of your last period. They enable us to confirm that your pregnancy is in the uterus, establish a beating heart, and determine the gestational age and expected due date for your baby. The ultrasound pictures are reviewed by our Radiologists and a report is sent to our Medical Director,

who will contact you with the results.

This is a picture of a baby sucking its thumb. This baby is only 12 weeks old, but has the ability to be comforted in the safety of mom's womb.
